You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. And these words I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

- The Ten Commandments: Exodus 20:1-17

- 1) And God spoke all these words, saying, I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shall have no other gods before Me.
- 2) Thou shall not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. Thou shall not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them. For I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me, and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments.
- 3) Thou shall not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh His name in vain.
- 4) Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shall thou labor and do all thy work. But the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD thy God. In it thou shall not do any work: thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy



cattle, nor the stranger that is within thy gates. For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Wherefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.

- 5) Honor thy father and thy mother that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God is giving thee.
- 6) Thou shall not murder.
- 7) Thou shall not commit adultery.
- 8) Thou shall not steal.
- 9) Thou shall not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
- 10) Thou shall not covet thy neighbor's house, thou shall not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is thy neighbor's.
